General Information

ENTRY: Registration available online or on-site. **NO refunds for failure to compete.** Participants **MUST** present proof of current USA Wrestling Membership Card (actual card or photo copy) at registration AND weigh-ins.

until 10:00 PM (Mountain Standard) Monday, April 2nd. Entry fee for participants registering on-line is \$35. The **OFFICIAL WAIVER & REGISTRATION FORMS** will be completed electronically when registering online.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION (Cash or Check): Entry fee for participants registering at the door is \$50 — all checks made payable to "USA Wrestling." If registering on-site, the **OFFICIAL WAIVER & REGISTRATION FORMS** (available for download at www.themat.com) must be accurately completed and filed at registration.

NO REGISTRATION BY MAIL WILL BE ACCEPTED!

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: Attractive National Championship awards to the top eight (8) place winners in each weight class of the Kids, Cadet and Junior Divisions and the top three (3) place winners of the Veterans division.

TEAM AWARDS: Awards will be given to the top two (2) clubs in each Kids Division (Bantam, Midget, Novice, and Schoolboy/girl). To be eligible, the club **MUST BE SANCTIONED** by USA Wrestling.

RULES: National Federation of State High School Association scoring rules will govern the competition. USA Wrestling rules governing ages, weights and match time will take precedence where applicable.

UNIFORMS: Singlets with under briefs required. Singlets will be available for purchase at the event. Headgear is required for all competitors in the Kids Divisions. Shoelaces must be taped!

PAIRINGS: Double-elimination line-bracketing with complete wrestle-backs to eighth (8th) place for the Kids, Cadet and Junior Divisions and third (3rd) place for the Veteran's division. 2007 USAW Folkstyle All-Americans will be separated. When possible, wrestlers from the same state will also be separated.

COACHING: A floor pass is required. Coaches floor passes will only be issued to those individuals with a current USAW Coaches Membership Card and who are USAW NCEP Copper certified for Kids and Cadets and USAW NCEP Bronze certified for Juniors (photo I.D. required). Please note, Bronze Certification **WILL NOT** be available during this event. Coaches Membership Cards should be obtained from your state office prior to the event, however, the cards will be available for purchase at the Copper Coaches Clinic. Two certified coaches are the maximum allowed in each competitor's corner. * To videotape any match at mat side, the operator must be one of the two certified coaches in the corner or have purchased a video pass.

MEDICAL INFORMATION: Athletes must be present in a **COMPETITION SINGLET** and must submit to a skin disease screening prior to weigh-in. The chief medical officer has full authority without appeal in determining the eligibility of an athlete to compete. In the event of injury or illness, no contestant will be permitted to continue the competition without approval of the Chief Medical Officer, whose decision is final and is not subject to appeal.

WEIGH-INS: Each athlete will be allowed two consecutive attempts to make weight and may not leave the weigh-in area. All wrestlers must be dressed in a **COMPETITION SINGLET** for weigh-ins and no weight allowance is given for the singlet.

ELIGIBILITY: All athletes who meet age group requirements, any existing state qualifying procedures (see below) and are current members of USA Wrestling are eligible to participate.

STATE QUALIFYING INFORMATION: If you are a resident of a state listed below, you must meet your state's qualification procedures to participate in the ASICS USAW Folkstyle National Championships. If your state is not listed, there is no prequalification required. **There are no prequalifications for the Veteran's Divisions (all states) and the Junior Division in Minnesota.**

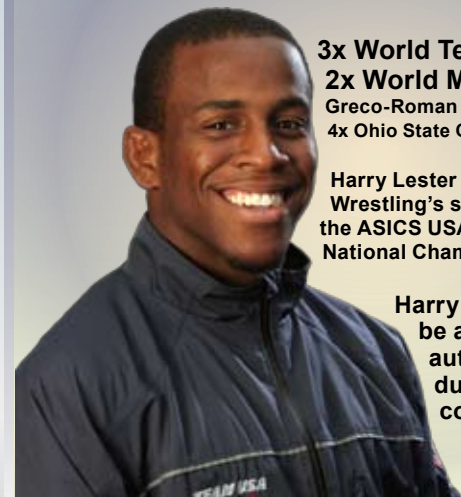
